### **Fees:**

Entry fee is \$8.00 for each individual event an athlete enters and \$32.00 per relay team. No entry fee will be transferred or refunded. Make all checks payable to USATF Illinois. Entries will not be processed unless the entry fee is received by the deadline.

### **Eligibility:**

This meet is a Youth invite and Open and Masters Association Championship. USATF membership is not required for the youth division. However, Open and Masters athletes must have a 2009 USATF membership. Open and Masters athletes do not have a limit on the number of events that they can compete in. Open athletes are athletes that are 19 through 29 years of age (The athlete is 19 between January 1, 2009 and August 2, 2009. Birth dates that are between August 3 and December 31, 2009 compete in the youth division).

Masters athletes will be competing in age groups and must compete in the same division (cannot mix open and masters events) throughout the meet. Open and Masters athletes that are outside of Illinois can compete in this championship.

### Entries via On-Line

All teams and unattached athletes must utilize the online entry process at the following location: [www.kompusport.net](http://www.kompusport.net). The on-line entry system is available from Sunday, January 11, 2009, through Monday, February 2, 2009; at 9:00 pm, cst. USATF membership numbers are required at time of registration. The option to pay by credit card is available.

Immediately after registering online, teams must print a receipt from the website and then mail the receipt to the address below with full payment if you did not pay on-line. **The entry confirmation and fee must be received by Thursday, February 5<sup>th</sup> by 5:00 p.m. No exceptions!**

### Entries via Hy-Tek Team Manager

Those submitting entries via Hy-Tek Team Manager must submit entries via the import routine at the above on-line process. The event file that is required in Hy-Tek is available at the on-line entry website.

### Check-In Requirements:

A packet will be provided for each team consisting of team roster and events entered. A team representative is responsible for picking up the packet. Packets can be picked up at the track facility on meet date beginning at 7:00 a.m. Be sure to bring birth certificates and USATF cards when you pick up packets.

### Awards:

Individual event awards will be presented to participants who finish 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> place. Relay participants will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes.

### Officials:

### Facility:

The Proviso West field house has an awesome track. The facility boasts a 9-lane straightaway as well as 6 lanes around the oval. Only ¼" or smaller pyramid spikes are allowed. Christmas tree spikes are not allowed. Spikes will be inspected on the track.

Fully Automatic Timing will be provided using Finishlynx Cameras interfaced with Hy-Tek Meet Manager.

No radios, glass containers, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the facility.

***Equipment:***

Starting blocks and batons will be provided.
